School Watch – Western Wards

“School Watch” is a new initiative being set up by your local Safer Neighbourhood Police teams (SNPT) in the Western Wards. The scheme is already in place in other forces and has been very successful, preventing criminal damage and keeping the schools in the scheme safer, and more aware of their surroundings.



School Watch in Park Gate is on trial at all the schools in the Western wards (i.e. Infants, Juniors and Brookfield Secondary school).

SNPT have canvassed all houses adjacent to a school in the area with an information leaflet reminding residents of the correct numbers to call to report issues to the Police. The SNPT team are encouraging residents to report any incidents such as suspicious vehicles or persons, youths in the school, noise after hours etc.

Future aim of School Watch is to have a central email facility for school staff, pupils and members of the public to use to forward any relevant school information, such as school inset days, school holidays etc. The emails will be accessed by SNPT and any relevant information will be forwarded to all the schools in the area for information.

The fundamental purpose of School Watch is to work in Partnership with Police, Council and School bodies to keep our schools safe and free from crime, anti social behaviour and criminal damage.
